

Hans F. Koenig Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the staff of The Upper Salmon Basin Watershed Program in memory of Hans Koenig. It has been made possible by the sacrifice and caring of multiple donors. Hans had a career in wildlife management that spanned a time period of nearly 30 years. He was especially passionate about reptiles and had a deep appreciation for our resources and a respect for wildlife.

- Applicant must be a qualifying High School student, including Home Schooled students OR a student presently enrolled in college, university or technical school. Previous High School graduates planning to enroll in college, university or technical school are also eligible.
- Special consideration will be given to students raised in fatherless, motherless, or single parent households as well as single parents attending or returning to school.
- Special consideration will also be given to those whose intended field of study is Herpetology, Wildlife Management, Conservation Officer or Environmental Studies.
- Applicant must be accepted (or enrolled) in a college, university or technical/vo-tech school. Graduating seniors should provide copy of letter of acceptance.
- GPA 2.50 or greater (provide **official unopened** transcript or a copy of an official transcript) which states ACT and/or SAT score.
- Essay: up to 2 pages double spaced. Essay should portray why this scholarship is important to you and why this education is essential to your career goals. Some suggestions: Discuss your future aspirations and your how you plan to use your education to achieve your goals. Discuss any community or volunteer work that you have participated in. Discuss any jobs you have had and the impact they have had on your life.
- Submit two current letters of recommendation. Letters should not be from relatives.
